School Goals

Needs assessments are still underway. Teachers are working on reading assessments now. Developing goals over next several weeks. In past, goals have included items like “percentage of students reading at grade level.” Summer loss of proficiency is a continuing challenge.

For formal goals, looking like 2 reading goals, 2 math goals, 1 targeted attendance goal.

- Likely a Chancellor’s goal based on iReady for grades 2-5 in math.
- Perhaps a targeted attendance goal for truant, non-excused absences.
- Possibly a fluency metric based on reading words per minute. Not sure about grade level yet.

We had a 70% school-wide goal for home visits under Flamboyant Year 2. Visits can be at any point during the year. We are not going to include a Flamboyant goal as one of the formal goals this year, given that we are already moving forward in integrating the program throughout the school

Community Survey

Institute regular input via survey. Cody has a draft instrument that we can discuss at the next meeting.

CAG suggests getting input on “What does Maury not have that you would want? What one facility, extracurricular, communication improvement, etc.”
