1. Introductions
 - a. Members of LSAT were introduced, including Charles Moore as a Community Representative. Elizabeth Nelson is also a Community Representative.
 2. Select Teacher Co-chair
 - a. Kira Kliment was selected as staff Co-Chair.
 3. Review 2016 PARCC results and discuss response
 - a. Principal Albert-Garvey discussed the chasm between the PARCC scores of African American and caucasian students. We also discussed the significant drop in PARCC scores from 4th to 5th grade (top 30% students left after 4th grade this past academic year).
 - b. Discussed possible benefits to early identification and/or intervention with higher needs/at-risk kids.
 4. Review school level goals
 - a. Discussed Maury ES/EC Comprehensive School Plan: 2016-2017 Packet for details Action Steps. Highlights include: Daily Foundations instruction K-2, raising awareness of summer loss in reading, renewed partnership with ANET coaching, need for explicit teaching in test taking, purchased 100 iReady accounts for highest needs (possibility of purchasing more if needed), small group intervention. See packet for a much more detailed list of Action Steps.
 - b. By June 2017, 58% of students 2nd-5th will be on grade level on iReady EOY assessment.
 - c. By June 2017, 60% of 5th grade students will be on grade level on iReady EOY assessment.
